**Cascade Die Casting Group receives multiple National Safety Awards;
NADCA Outstanding Safety Award and Amerisure Insurance Safety Award**

GRAND RAPIDS, MI...For the third year in a row Cascade Die Casting Group, Inc. has received the Outstanding Safety Award from the North American Die Cast Association (NADCA). This NADCA annual award recognizes companies in the die cast industry that exceed industry criteria to operate a safe working environment for their employees. All three of Cascade Die Casting Groups divisions, MidState in Grand Rapids, MI, Great Lakes in Sparta, MI and Atlantic in High Point, NC received this award for their exemplary safety records.

Cascade Die Casting has also been awarded the Amerisure Insurance Safety Award, in recognition of outstanding performance regarding lost time injury. From June 2006 to May 2010 Cascade's Midstate Division went 1,427 days without a lost time injury and the Great Lakes Division went 1,398 days without a lost time injury.

Shea Coon, Director of Human Resource said, "Receiving both awards (NADCA and Amerisure Insurance) validates the importance we place on safety. All the credit goes to the employees. They work in an environment that can be dangerous, and their constant attention to safety has allowed us to be successful with our safety record. I applaud their efforts and constant attention to detail in maintaining a safe working environment, which benefits not only themselves but their co-workers and families."

Safety is a company wide effort at Cascade Die Casting Group. The company maintains safety committees at each division, holds monthly 'safety chats' in small groups on the manufacturing floor on current safety topics, provides a safety incentive for each month with no lost time accidents, and works with their insurance carrier to conduct training on various safety topics.

When potential safety hazards are identified, Cascade Die Casting Group strives to take immediate action to follow up and put corrective actions in place to prevent an incident. The company also shares best practices in safety between it's locations to promote standardization and continuous improvement.
