New Business Announcement

Cascade Die Casting Group secures over \$10M of new business in the first half of CY2010.

New contracts were established with several companies during the past six months with highlights following;

- A market leader in the production of off road sport vehicles has signed contracts to purchase product that will house the drive systems that power their products – these castings will be purchased as cast/machined/and leak tested, thus further expanding our value added business approach and high degree of competency in producing porosity sensitive, high integrity applications. These applications will be going into production in late CY2010 and early CY2011.
- A major player in the Automotive power train field has brought Cascade on to develop two new programs – both applications requiring highly capable process controls due to their porosity sensitive nature and performance requirements. These castings will launch in CY2010 and represents a new customer for Cascade.
- A Major Tier 1 automotive supplier has signed contracts to purchase several housing and cover applications for two programs they are developing – both programs will go into production in early CY2011. This business further expands our relationship with this customer.
- The market leader in automotive wiper systems has signed contracts to purchase a bracket for production beginning fall of CY2010. This is another new customer for Cascade and further strengthens our Blue Chip customer portfolio.
- One of the leaders in the development of Electric vehicle systems has committed new business to Cascade for their new system which will launch in the fall of CY2010. Again, another new customer for Cascade and growth into new markets.
